Fraud

CPD Case# 16-47572-OF

(CONCORD, NH) - The Concord Police Department is asking the public for their assistance in identifying the suspect in a recent fraud that occurred at a Concord business.

The crime, under investigation, occurred on December 9th at Walmart located at 344 Loudon Road. The suspect in this incident is a white female and she is accused of committing Identity Fraud by illegally establishing a credit card account using another person's identity. The fraudulent account was then immediately used to purchase approximately \$1482.94 in merchandise.

The victim in this incident is from Berlin, NH and has reported the fraudulent activity to the Berlin Police Department.



Evidence has been recovered in relation to this incident.

The Concord Police Department has recovered video surveillance from store security and is asking the public to assist in identifying an individual of interest depicted in the photograph.
