Stabbing

(CONCORD, NH)- The Concord Police Department is asking the public for their assistance with an altercation that took place on March 24, 2017. At approximately 11:09 PM, Concord police officers responded to a downtown residence for the report of a disturbance. Arriving officers discovered a male subject who had been stabbed by another male. The individual was transported by the Concord Fire Department to the Concord Hospital where they were treated for a non-life threatening wound.

Investigators are still working on this case. It is believed that the two men knew each other and the incident may have been related to narcotics.
