Vandalism

(CPD# 17-14331-OF)

(CONCORD, NH) - The Concord Police Department is asking the public for their assistance in identifying the suspect in a recent act of Criminal Mischief (vandalism) that occurred at a Concord business.

The crime under investigation occurred on Tuesday April 25 when officers responded to a report of Criminal Mischief at Phenix Hall (42 N Main St). The south side of the building adjacent the fire escape was tagged with spray paint indicating that the suspect accessed the fire escape to commit the crime. Also on the building several doors were tagged with paint. Officers investigating the incident believe that the damage occurred sometime on April 25-April 26 between 4pm – 8am. The Concord Police Department has recovered images of the tagging. Images of the tagging are attached.
