Theft

(CPD# 17-2416-OF)

(CONCORD, NH) - The Concord Police Department is asking the public for their assistance in identifying the suspects in a recent theft of merchandise that occurred at a Concord business.

The crime under investigation occurred on the evening of April 8, 2017 at Banks Chevrolet on Manchester St. Unknown suspects stole approximately \$12,000 worth of tires, rims, and vehicle accessories from new vehicles. A review of surveillance video indicates at least two suspects committed the thefts. Video was able to identify a possible suspect vehicle. The vehicle appears to be a light-colored Toyota Tacoma Single Cab pickup. The truck has modifications to it which include a Back Rack and Black rims with silver inlays, and is possibly a TRD (Toyota Racing Development) custom truck. The Concord Police are looking for information to identify the two suspects in the surveillance video and any information to identify the vehicle.

The Concord Police Department is asking the public to assist in identifying an individual(s) of interest depicted in the photographs.
