On May 14<sup>th</sup> at approximately 10:00 AM 2 officers on bicycle patrol in the area of Storrs Street near the railroad tracks were dispatched to a report of two subjects inside an abandoned building, possibly stripping metal. The building in question is privately owned and is posted "No Trespassing".

As the officers approached the building they could hear the sound of someone pounding against metal. An officer noticed what appeared to be scrap metal being thrown out onto the ground from a second story window. With the assistance of other officers, two subjects were located inside the building. These subjects were later identified as Vazquez and Anderson.

Officers determined that neither subject had permission to be inside the building. Based on the observation of the responding officers, both subjects were arrested for burglary.

Both subjects were transported to Concord PD for processing. They both refused bail and will be arraigned this morning at the 6th Circuit District Division, Concord, NH.
