Armed Robbery

CONCORD, NH - The Concord Police Department is asking the public for their assistance with a Robbery that took place on May 31, 2017.

At approximately 4:46 pm, Concord police officers responded to Dunkin Donuts on Manchester Street for the report of an armed robbery. The suspect was armed with a knife and fled the area on foot.
