Robbery Suspect Photos – Shell Gas Station

CONCORD, NH - The Concord Police Department is asking the public for their assistance with a robbery that took place on June 1, 2017. This is the fourth robbery that police have responded to since May 28, 2017.

At approximately 1:43 am, Concord police officers responded to the Shell gas station on Loudon Road for the report of an armed robbery. The suspect told the clerk he had a gun and the clerk thought they saw an outline of a gun in the suspect's pocket.

The suspect was described as a white male in his 20's wearing a black hat, grey hoodie and black shorts. Attached are surveillance photos of the suspect. The clerk also thought that this suspect resembled suspects in photos from other recent robberies in Concord.
