IDENTIFICATION OF WITNESSES TO SUSPICIOUS SUBJECT'S LEWD CONDUCT

CONCORD, NH – The Concord Police Department is asking the public for their assistance regarding a call for a suspicious person near a popular swimming area along Turkey Pond in Concord on July 22, 2017.

Officers responded to the area after witnesses who were swimming called to report an adult male committing indecent exposure and lewd behaviors.
