Attempted Murder

CONCORD – On August 24, 2017 at approximately 1:44 PM Concord Police responded to the Mobil station at 81 South Main Street for a report of a man that tried to run people over with his car. Responding Officers learned that a man that had applied for a job had come to inquire about his application. He then lured store employees out of the store and the man then tried to run them over. The man struck the protective barrier around the pumps while trying to run over the employees.

A short time later, a man identified as 41 year old William Soler, presented himself in the lobby of the Concord Police station and stated that he was the person we were looking for.

Subsequent investigation revealed that the man attempted to run over the store employees and resulted in his arrest. Mr. Soler was arrested and charged with Attempted Murder, Reckless Conduct x2, and Attempted First Degree Assault. He will be arraigned in the Merrimack County Superior Court on August 25, 2017 at 1 PM.
